2016/2017 accomplishments

In July I will be sending out a summary of our councils accomplishments for the last fraternal year. We sometimes forget all the work that is performed and it is good to review at least once a year how we did. Hopefully it will also serve as an information sheet that may give you ideas about projects you want to be active in and support as well as information you can use in recruiting new members.

CARDINAL EVENTS

The Cardinal contractor, ROJO Group, released the schedule for events they want us to work. There are 18 events schedules so far, 10 Cardinal games, the Fiesta Bowl, two soccer games, 2 monster jams, 2 concerts and a supper cross event. We will need to provide 7 volunteers for each event who will work the beer and pizza stands. The schedule starts on July 20 with a Gold Cup Soccer and then on August 4 with a Metallica concert and two Cardinal (preseason?) games on August 12 and 19. There will be 3 events in September, and October, 2 in November, 4 in December and 1 each in January and February. There may be more events if the Cardinals make the playoffs.

Clearly we will be needing a lot of volunteers to work the schedule. Last year we earned @ \$20,000 from these events and this was our larger fund raising program. If you haven't worked any of these before, check with Butch on getting trained. If you have, sign off on the volunteer agreement for this year and let Butch know what events you can work. Ideally, please schedule for the season, if you can't do that, try to schedule at least a month in advance so he can be sure to have the needed coverage. If you have any questions talk to Butch Kohs. PS at the 4th degree meeting on the 28th he indicated he still hasn't received the signed volunteer agreements from all the folks who are already and trained needs info on who can work what events as he needs to schedule especially in the next couple of months.
